There were a number of fence sitters who also gained much from the clinic. All the feedback has been good.

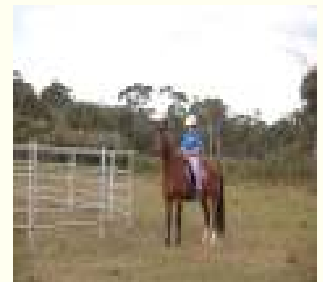
Wayne is holding another clinic on the 22nd and 23rd August - we hope we have the same group plus more.

- ◇ **Clinics** - Wayne specializes in coaching. Wayne has his Level One accreditation in Coaching and loves to teach natural horsemanship. This style of training one's horse suits every discipline because the foundation of training any horse, is understanding the horse and how it moves thus working with the horse not against it.
- ◇ **Starting and Education of horses** - Another of Wayne's specialties is starting and educating the young horse ready for the owner to take it over. # LEARNING PATHWAYS

## COORDINATION AND TIMING

*This is the 2nd lesson in a series of sharing 'Learning Pathways' with you*

Coordination on both sides of the body is important to avoid confusion in the horse and an unbalanced horse. Practice rope techniques, as learned in the clinics, at home without the horse. Become fluent and smooth with the rope as it will become one your most important tools for groundwork. We expect our horses to be balanced, so to achieve that we need also, to be balanced. This skill will follow through to being in the saddle so the use of the right and left side of your body will need to be even.

Timing is paramount because it is actually the release that teaches the horse. Based on the comfort/discomfort philosophy, it is the timing of the quit or

release. If the timing is wrong, it will probably result in a reaction from your horse rather than a response. Remember also your phases of firmness - again based on comfort/discomfort philosophy. Attending training clinics will teach you the methodology and the philosophy behind this skill.

## REWARD

**Reward the horse, this goes hand in hand with respect. Reward is comfort - comfort is allowing the horse to do nothing, digesting the thought, giving the horse time. Some need more time than others. Body language will tell you when the horse is ready to continue. Rubbing the horse is preferable than patting. Horses rub each other not pat.**
